The books in this box have been special your fabulous librarian just for you! They are a little different than the types of books you usually read, but give them a chance, you might be surprised.

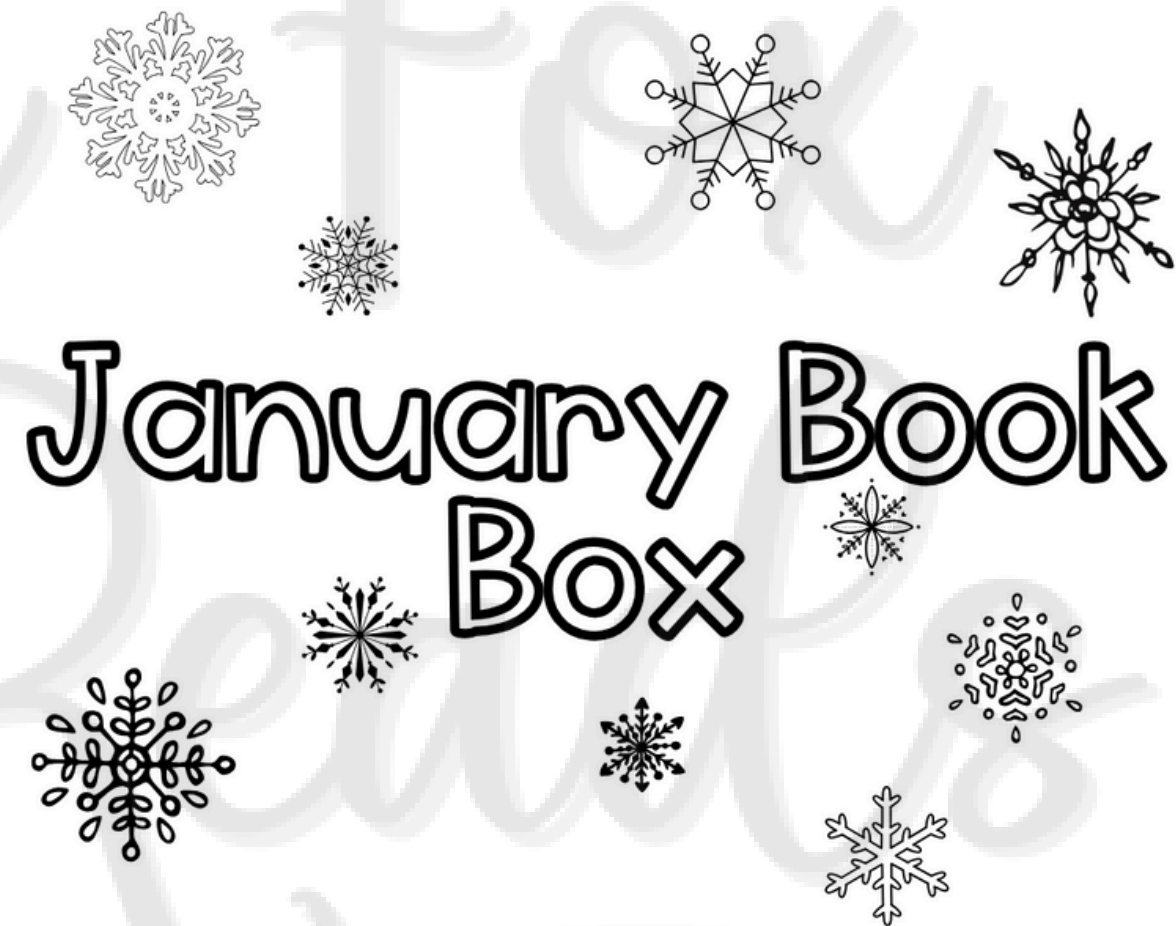
A lot of thought went into picking books that would be a good fit, but sometimes we do get it wrong. If your books are NOT the right fit for you, no worries. We can help find another one.

★ Don't forget, the books in this box are due in 2 weeks. Be sure to bring them to the library when you're done. Our librarian will recheck them if you're late.

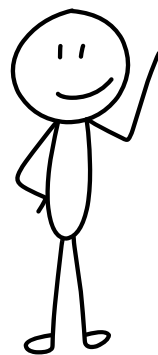

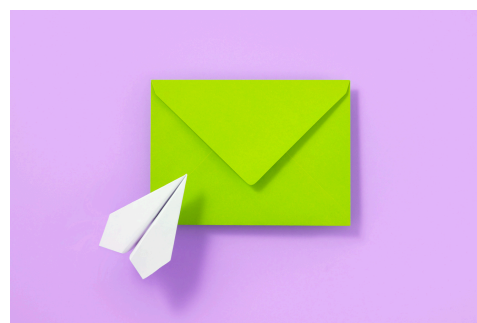
