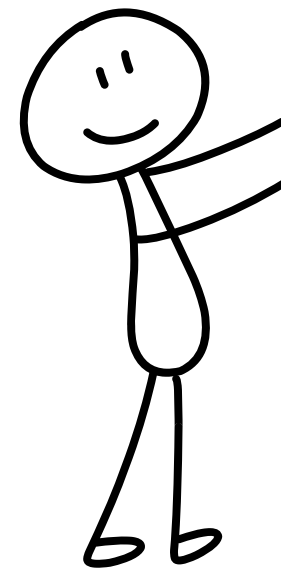

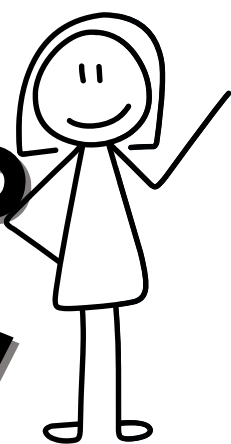


# Think About It...

- **This game gets loud, but will definitely get your students engaged and excited about coming back to the library**

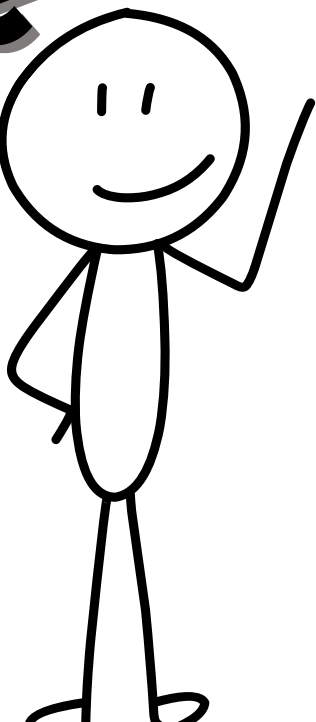
## RULES
